Your terminal is connected to a VTAM network where you have access to a number of applications. If your work requires more than one of these applications, you may have to repeatedly log off one and log on to another. This can become a time-consuming task that takes up system resources. CA TPX Session Management solves this problem by letting you access all your applications from a single menu and switch from application to application.

In this course, you will learn about using ACL/E (Automated Conversation Language - Extended) programs with CA TPX and how to use the major commands available for ACL/E programs. This course content is presented as an overview of the product and its features.
